

## **FAQs for CII-SKA Scholarship Scheme**

To help the college students better understand the CII-SKA Scholarship Scheme and to fill out the forms accurately, we are giving below some commonly asked questions and their answers:

**1. Question:** Who can apply for CII-SKA Scholarship ?

**Answer:** Students who have taken admission / pursuing under-graduate programme (B.Sc. / B. Tech.) in Food Science / Food Technology / Dairy Technology / Food Processing / Food Microbiology / Food Safety / Nutrition can apply for this scholarship.

**2. Question:** What is the eligibility criteria for application ?

**Answer:** Following are the criteria for applying for the CII-SKA Scholarship:

- Students must have completed without any break;
- I semester for II semester scholarship;
- I and II semester, for the second year scholarship;
- III and IV semester, for the third year scholarship;
- V and VI semester, for fourth year scholarship
- The student should have cleared all the courses of the concerned semester in the first attempt;
- All papers must have been cleared with a 60% score or B grade
- The annual gross income of parents of student from all sources does not exceed Rs. 2,50,000.

**3. Question:** If the result of last semester is still not available, can the mark-sheets of the previous semester be considered ?

**Answer:** No. Your last semester results are important as that forms the basis of considering your scholarship application.

**4. Question:** Can a candidate apply for CII-SKA scholarship if he is already receiving a scholarship from another source ?

**Answer:** Yes. However, it is necessary to declare information about sanction / receipt of scholarship along with the amount of scholarship in the application form at S. No. 8 of Part A of the form. Please see condition No. 8 and 9 under "F. Other Conditions".

**5. Question:** Is there any other condition applicable for being eligible for the scholarship ?

**Answer:** Yes. Please read "F. Other Conditions" mentioned in the scheme. These are compulsorily applicable and, in case of violation, the scholarship is liable to be withdrawn.

**6. Question:** What documents are required to be submitted with the application ?

**Answer:** Following documents are required with the filled and signed application form:

- Documents as per S. No. 3, 7, 8, 9 of Part A of the application form;
- Documents mentioned at S. No. 17 to 20, as applicable, under Part B;
- Annual reports / Mark-sheets attested by the Principal / Director / Professor In-charge / HOD along with the College stamp;
- Completed and signed Verification Certificate by the College.

**7. Question:** Is PAN Card and Adhaar Card necessary for applying for this scholarship ?

**Answer:** Yes, these are required. Please see Parts A and B of the application form.

**8. Question:** Is the Verification necessary to be submitted ?

**Answer:** Yes. It is an essential document and it **MUST** be completely filled in and signed by the Principal / Director / Professor In-charge / HOD along with the College stamp.

**9. Question:** What is the last date of submitting the application form ?

**Answer:** (a) For Continuing Students -- 16 August, 2018;

(b) For New Students -- 15 September, 2018.

The last date will not be extended.

**10. Question:** How do I send the forms to CII-FACE ?

**Answer:** The completed forms should be sent by courier to the following address:

**11. Question:** Should the student send the application or should it be sent by the College ?

**Answer:** The completed application can be sent by courier by the student as long it is in a cover sealed by the College.

**12. Question:** When and how will I come to know of the decision of grant of scholarship ?

**Answer:** The decision on grant of the scholarship will be communicated by e-mail to the student, his / her parents as well as the College. Since CII-SKA has extended the last date for submission of completed applications as mentioned at S. No. 9 above, the decision on grant of the scholarship as well as the amount of scholarship approved by CII-SKA will be communicated in October, 2018.
