# Announcing the CII-SKA Merit-cum-Means Scholarship for Undergraduate Students of Food Technology/ Microbiology, Nutrition and Home Science

The **Surakshit Khadya Abhiyan (SKA)**, is a pan-India initiative of CII to promote Food Safety through Awareness & Capacity Building of stakeholders connected with food products.

SKA is aligned with the “Jago Grahak Jago” campaign of Ministry of Consumer Affairs and Prime Minister’s “Swachh Bharat Abhiyan”, and was launched in 2015 by Shri Ram Vilas Paswan, Minister of Consumer Affairs, Food & Public Distribution in July 2015.

## 3 activities have been initiated under SKA for the year 2018:

- 3 short term courses in Food Safety areas have been designed and have been forwarded by FSSAI to the Universities for introduction in their curriculum
- SKA Asia Quiz Competition on Food Safety of undergraduate students of Food Technology / Food Safety / Food Microbiology / Nutrition etc
- Grant Scholarship to students pursuing in these areas of Food Science at the undergraduate level



## Aim of the Scholarship Initiative

It is aimed to give scholarships every year on a merit-cum-means basis. The aim of the Scholarship is to:

Promote Food Safety amongst the future generation

Facilitate education for needy and meritorious students in the field of Food Technology/ Microbiology, Nutrition and Home Science

Strengthen the student connect with SKA

## Eligibility Criteria

Indian students who have taken new admission/ pursuing Undergraduate Degree programme in Food Technology/ Microbiology, Nutrition and Home Science are eligible for the scholarship

This scholarship would be provided to deserving students having good academic record but require financial support

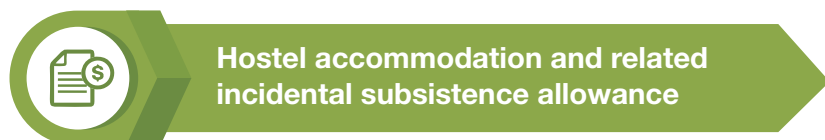
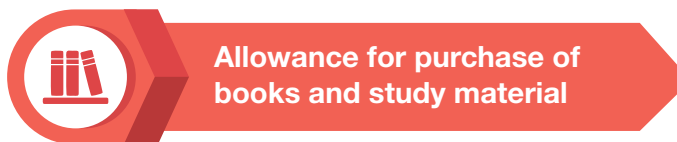
In case of continuing student, he/she must have completed without any break:

- I semester for II semester scholarship;
- I and II semester, for the second year scholarship;
- III and IV semester, for the third year scholarship;
- V and VI semester, for the fourth year scholarship.

The student should have cleared all the courses of the concerned semester in the first available chance
